Southwest Florida: the pinewoods, the hardwood hammocks, the everglades (including cypress swamps and sawgrass prairies), and marine life (including coral reefs.) A fifth habitat, mangrove swamps, will be completed

"Close Encounters" offers a new hands-on experience built around two multi-cubicle tables each containing South Florida

inhabitants Computer programs include one on the behavior of bees corresponding with a living bee hive in the marine life habitat.

Traveling exhibits, furnished by the Smithsonian Institute, are scheduled: December 5-January 13 "Unfamiliar Fauna of the Open Sea"; February 3 - March 3 "Upifer and its Moons"; March 3 -March 31 "Flying Fantasies" (moths & butterflies)
